You may already be aware that [Norwich Research School](#) (at NDHS) is designated by the [Education Endowment Foundation](#) (EEF) to provide school-led support for evidence-based practice. As the Norfolk hub for the Research Schools Network, we provide Communication, Training and Innovation opportunities. We recognise that every school's needs and capacity are different, and have therefore defined various 'support levels' to cater for all.

We are delighted to be able to announce our training programmes for 2019-20 (all bookable via our website):

- **Leading Learning:** this training for senior leaders supports schools to improve the effectiveness of their teacher professional development, by deepening their knowledge and understanding of the related evidence
- **Effective use of the Pupil Premium:** this training for senior leaders responsible for the Pupil Premium leads schools to develop, implement and sustain an evidence-based, high impact Pupil Premium strategy
- **Metacognition:** this training supports teachers, middle leaders, and senior leaders to deliver on the potential high impact of metacognitive and self-regulation strategies
- **Improving Maths at KS2 and 3:** in partnership with the Angles Maths Hub, this training for both primary and secondary teachers and leaders enables application of the evidence on effective Mathematics teaching
- **Preparing for Literacy:** in partnership with EYFS providers in Norwich, this training for EYFS teachers, middle and senior leaders explores the evidence on Early Literacy development and implications for teaching
- **Improving Secondary Literacy:** this training is aimed at secondary teachers, middle and senior leaders, and is based around the evidence on Disciplinary (subject-specific) literacy teaching.
